SENATOR VENDITTE: I understand. Mr. Speaker, one other additional point for clarification then, would it then be in order for me to add a particular amendment or an amendment to a bill that perhaps may be on General File or even Select File at this point in time?

PRESIDENT: I suppose...it can be put on. It would be put in the record. Would it not? You would print it in the Journal then for the final day. Yes, if it is printed and everything would be just put into the Journal and then it would be ready to go next year.

SENATOR VENDITTE: Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

PRESIDENT: All right, any other questions? Otherwise the Sergeant at Arms will see to it that all members are in the chamber, that all members are at their desks and we will proceed with the Final Reading, the final day this session. Speaker Marvel, do you want to make the motions to suspend the rules because for all these bills we will have to suspend the rules? So the Chair recognizes Speaker Marvel for purposes of suspending the rules.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I move that the rules be suspended so we can take up Final Reading for today.

PRESIDENT: All right, is there any discussion on the motion to suspend the rules in order that we might take up today's agenda #5 on Final Reading? If not, all those in favor of suspending the rules vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: No.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays to suspend the rules and take up Final Reading today, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: I hope there is a quorum present. Okay, the motion carries and the rules are suspended and good morning and we will proceed now with agenda item #5, Final Reading, LB 11, Mr. Clerk, read on Final Reading. Would everybody get returned to their desks as soon as possible. Would all of the members return to their desks so we can commence with Final Reading. As soon as all the members are at their desks, Senator Merz, why we will commence with the Final Reading today. Mr. Clerk, you may commence reading LB 11.
