SPEAKER MARVEL: I move, Mr. President, that a committee of five be appointed to advise the Governor that the Eighty-Sixth Legislature, Second Session, of the Nebraska Legislature is convened and is ready for the transaction of business.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to advise the Governor and to appoint a committee to get the Governor and advise him. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the motion, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion to advise the Governor is adopted and the Chair will appoint the following committee to go to the office of the Governor: Senator Clark, Senator DeCamp, Senator Kremer, Senator Lewis and Senator Warner. The Legislature will be at ease until the committee returns.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Sergeant at Arms Ray Wilson.

SERGEANT AT ARMS: Mr. President, your committee, having waited on the Governor, have now returned and have a message for the Chair.

PRESIDENT: The committee may proceed to deliver the message from the Governor. The Clerk will read the message from the Governor.

CLERK: (Read message from the Governor as found on page 37 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: Mr. Clerk, do you want to at this time read some matters into the record?

CLERK: Mr. President, the first material I have is the official roster as presented to me by the Secretary of State designating the membership for the Eighty-Sixth Legislature, Second Session. (See pages 37-39 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, I have in my possession the official appointment and oath of Bill Barrett as a member of the Legislature from the 39th Legislative District. Attached thereto, Mr. President, the gubernatorial appointment as well as the oath of office signed by Senator Barrett.
