The motion then before the house is the adoption of proposed rule change #6 as amended. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote. A record vote has been requested.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 128-129 of the Legislative Journal.) 31 ayes, 11 nays, 7 not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The proposed rule change #6 is adopted. Mr. Speaker, you have one more that I understand is noncontroversial. Do you want to try to get it in before you recess? Senator Fowler, is that true, #7, is there going to be much discussion on #7?

SENATOR FOWLER: I think there may be some discussion on #7, so maybe we can take that up after lunch.

PRESIDENT: All right, Mr. Speaker. The Chair recognizes Speaker Marvel.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Well I was going to recess until 1:30. It is now six after so I will recess until 1:40 today and with the understanding that when we come back we will continue with rule changes.

PRESIDENT: All right, the motion then is to recess until 1:40?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes.

PRESIDENT: All those in favor of recessing until 1:40 signify by saying aye, opposed nay. We are recessed until 1:40 p.m.
