done with these rules, the whole sections, we can have him explain his alternative to these sections. The changes with regard to Section 5, Meeting Times, it consolidated the separate sections relating to meeting times and then it adds a section (c). If you are on page 8, Section 5 (c) indicates that a legislative committee will be subject to the call of its chairperson and it indicates also or to the call of any three of its members in accordance with notice and procedural requirements. So this does enable committee members to call a meeting of the committee as well as the chairman, three members. Section 6 on page 9 is just putting in one section the current methods that we use to select the chairs and vice chairs of committees.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Fowler.

SENATOR FOWLER: What?

SPEAKER MARVEL: There are two that want to speak. Do you propose to go through the twenty-two pages now?

SENATOR FOWLER: I would be glad to take a break.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Pardon?

SENATOR FOWLER: I would be glad to take a break and answer questions on sections.

SPEAKER MARVEL: First of all, I recognize Senator DeCamp and then we will recognize Senator Warner. Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Senator Fowler, just to clarify something so that we get off on the right foot in dealing with these, it is my understanding, and you correct me if I am wrong, that if we adopt these rules for committees there is no intent, even though it is not written anywhere, there is no intent or there has been agreement reached to delay these until the interim, July or something like that, so that people could learn these new rules of procedure rather than attempt to try to put the whole committee system into this right away, is that correct or not? Or is that acceptable?

SENATOR FOWLER: That would be acceptable to me to present the suggestion that these not take effect until the end of this session so that we would operate under the rules, existing rules, for committees for this session, and at the start of the interim, these new committee rules would go into effect.
