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has been reported out more than eight days. This is to try and establish a procedure to take care of that. The last section is existing language, investigating committees. That then is the proposed revamp of Rule 3. I would hope you note that several sections are essentially unchanged, that really in terms of controversy there may only be five of these sections that are of concern. I would be glad to entertain questions and also invite the rest of the Rules Committee to comment if they so wish.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there any other discussion on this section of the report from the Rules Committee? Is there any other discussion or any other questions? Any other comments from the Rules Committee members? Senator Beutler, do you wish to be recognized?

SENATOR BEUTLER: I would just like to make a brief comment if I could on Section 10.

SPEAKER MARVEL: What page is that on? Page 12.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, Steve went over that briefly, and as he indicated to you, what that section says basically with regard to the Model Committee Procedures is that each chairman, each committee, is going to have the choice of doing one of three things; adopting the Model Committee Rules; adopting them with modification; or forget about it completely and adopting their own set of comprehensive committee rules, if they want to go through the trouble to do that. Basically what we are hoping for is that the committee chairmen would take the Model Committee Rules and work with them and improve them; take them as they are, modify them as they see fit for their committee so that perhaps in a period of two or three years or more we could come up with a standard set of committee procedures that would be good for all committees. So as you are looking over the materials, I hope that you will pay more attention to the revamp of Rule 3 because that will be the rule immediately than you do to the Model Committee Procedures, because the Model Committee Procedures can be taken by the committee chairmen and the committees and modified or changed. They can do whatever they want with them. So it is not so essential that that be exactly as you want it as it is that the revamp of Rule 3 be exactly as you want it and I would encourage you then, if you don't have time to read all the materials carefully, to read the revamp of Rule 3 more carefully. Thank you.
