CLERK: I have nothing further, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, then the Chair would encourage the membership to bring the bills up as early tomorrow as possible for introduction, hopefully by ten o'clock, and also that I would encourage you to familiarize yourselves with the bills that you may have on General File. You should have a copy of tomorrow's agenda with you now so hopefully we can go through a number of these bills tomorrow. Is there any other business?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Sieck, would you like to adjourn us until nine o'clock tomorrow morning?

SENATOR SIECK: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, the first day of the session is now over and I wish to adjourn the Legislature until nine o'clock tomorrow morning.
