PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Fowler.

SENATOR FOWLER: Just to point out, this is on page 16 of the handout is the section 14 that is being amended, and also if you did not happen to bring back your copy of the Revamp of Rule Three, the Clerk and the staff have reprinted in the Journal the proposal and that is from page 133 on, and section 14 is found on page 141 of the Journal. So you can either look in the Journal or you can look at the handout that was handed out yesterday. It is the same thing, but it is page 16 in the handout. Page 141 of the Journal is the section that Senator Beutler is amending, and he has had handed out copies of his amendments. So you should have all of that before you.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Kelly. Thank you, Senator Kelly. Any other discussion then on the Beutler amendment? Senator Beutler, do you wish to close? Waive closing. The question then is the adoption of the Beutler amendment to the proposed rule change. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the motion, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The amendment is adopted. The Clerk has some matters to read in and then we will get to the...

CLERK: Mr. President, quickly, Senator Keyes offers an explanation of vote. (See Page 157 of the Legislative Journal.) Senator Marsh provides a Committee on Committees report designating Senator Kennedy as a replacement on Committee on Committees.

Two new bills, Mr. President, LB 663 offered by the Appropriations Committee and signed by the members thereof. (Read title to LB 663 as found on pages 157 and 158 of the Legislative Journal.) LB 664 offered by Senator Marsh of the 29th. (Read title to LB 664 as found on page 158 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: We have a few minutes. Does any member have any bills to introduce at this time? Again, trying to get them in before the noon recess. Apparently none of them are ready at this time. We will proceed then...Mr. Speaker, do you
