SEANTOR NICHOL: Okay, that is the way I understood it and that is what I wanted cleared. Thank you.

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. Speaker, a question of Senator Fowler.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Fowler.

SENATOR KELLY: Senator Fowler I haven't heard it referred to for sometime now, but yesterday I believe it was, I picked up a solid idea that in effect we were adopting model rules that committees could adopt if the committee chose to, or the committee could use those as a model in which they could change as they would see proper for their operation. Make changes in those models and adopt the changed set of rules. Is my position here correct?

SENATOR FOWLER: Right, in the Revamp of Rule Three that was adopted today, I believe that it is Section 10, cites the model committee rules which are Appendix A as an option for committees to adopt. If the committees do not adopt that option they must adopt some rules of their own. So it is a model that is available for committees to follow, it is specifically stated that committees must adopt some rules if they do not adopt that.

SENATOR KELLY: Thank you very much.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is on the adoption of...the motion is the Fowler proposal. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no.

CLERK: Senator Marvel voting aye.

SENATOR MARVEL: Have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 9 nays on the adoption of permanent rules as amended, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried. The Call is raised, I appreciate your cooperation. Senator Lewis has a...wants to explain the newspapers that were put on your desks. The Chair recognizes Senator Lewis.
