Okay, Mr. Sergeant at Arms, Ray, do you have a pencil and paper? Ray, Senator Chambers and Senator Schmit, please. Senator Merz, do you want to proceed with the roll call vote? There are two absent, Senator Schmit and Senator Chambers, and we have sent for them. The motion before the House is the indefinite postponement of LB 399. The Clerk will call the roll. The House is under Call. Will all legislators please take their seats. (Gavel) The motion is on the indefinite postponement of LB 399. All legislators will
