Number two, no, the bill will not stop a revenue reduction bill from being enacted because obviously we need those are going to pass before the final budget...the Legislature needs to know if they are going to pass before the final budget bills are considered. So it is the intent that any revenue reduction bill proceeds right straight across the Board and at no time would be held up.

SENATOR JOHNSON: Thank you, Senator Warner.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the committee amendments...Senator Warner, do you want to close on the committee amendments? All those in favor of the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 550 vote aye, opposed no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendments are adopted. Now, Senator Warner, do you want to move the bill as amended? I am sorry. We have got another amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: What this amendment does, I indicated on page 3 of the bill as it was introduced it required a thirty-three marginal vote to exceed the recommended level of appropriation for the previous year by seven percent striking all reference to any kind of percentage that was put in when that was a more popular figure a year ago, and all this merely states is that for the body to exceed what the recommended level that the Appropriations Committee is suggesting, that would require thirty-three votes and again it is for the purpose of expression
