

important because now we don't have records. We will have records of patient's disease, its progress and the effect of anything that laetrile and nutritional therapy has on various cancers. I feel that this is an effective way of finally determining the true amount of value that therapy or laetrile may or may not possess and this way it could be more widely used. It could be added to or amended, or if anything, if it is proven ineffective after it has been used and recorded and records kept, then it can be dropped from medical therapy in light of its own worth. The myths and the egos and the fears of all of us would be gone. We have gone over and over this and I know that I am allowed five minutes, but in the interest of time, I am going to turn over any balance of time I may have to either Senator Kahle or Senator Venditte, if they have anything additional to say.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You have thirty seconds left.

SENATOR KAHLE: Mr. Speaker, thank you, Senator Labeledz, I think we have discussed this at great length this afternoon. I looked up the transcript from last year and all I want to say is that I feel that people should have the right to use the substance laetrile if they think it will help in any way to relieve the disease, the symptoms or to make life easier for them during their last days. I think that is all there is to it. It is a matter of voting, we are ready to vote now. We asked last year for the privilege of voting. We are finally getting to that. I hope that everyone will vote their conviction and that we will settle it once and for all. Thank you very much.
