LB 222, 222A

PRESIDENT: Motion carries, debate ceases. Senator Maresh, you may close on...

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. President, I believe that the issue has been debated enough. I have no closing.

PRESIDENT: All right, the question before the House is the adoption of the Maresh amendment to LB 222. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Senator Maresh, what do you wish to do? Senator Maresh.....record the vote.

CLERK: 11 ayes, 16 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails, the amendment is not adopted. There are no further amendments?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: No further amendments, Senator DeCamp, what do you wish to do?

SENATOR DeCAMP: I move for the advancement of the bill. If there is nobody else....just vote I guess.

PRESIDENT: All right, the motion then is the advancement of the bill. That is Senator DeCamp's closing. All those in favor of advancing LB 222 to E & R Initial vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 7 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion passes and LB 222 is advanced to E & R Initial. Next take up LB 222A.

CLERK: Read LB 222A.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, I think that we should get a fiscal impact information on the bill as it is written now because the numbers in there are really completely meaningless. Richard has got some ideas for Select File as do some of the others maybe to hone down the cost so I'm not sure if we should hold it there or whether we advance it. Senator Warner is the Chairman of Appropriations, Senator Fowler is here, would we want to move it along with the bill and then put the correct numbers in later, hoping that we can make it very economical?

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner, do you have any comment on that as Appropriation's Chairman?
