PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Question.

PRESIDENT: Question has been called for. Do I see five hands? I do. All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, no nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries, debate ceases, Senator Sieck, are you closing or is Senator Simon closing? Senator Sieck, are you closing or is Senator Simon closing?

SENATOR SIECK: Yes, I would like to make a comment on Senator Kahle's feeling about individuals causing some difficulty. I happened to visit a small town in my area that had also some difficulty of young children throwing rocks at another individual and these were normal children. So I feel that these things will happen in any community whether they are mentally incapable or whether they are.....I think that this is something that if you look at all of our cities these things....do happen. I really feel that that is a pretty poor excuse. As a whole these children have more supervision than a family that is living with them and both working and the children are out on the streets. I feel that these type of individuals have a lot of care. I think with that I will close and we will just see what happens. I urge you to support 525.
