

two thousand to ten thousand would have...even if you would take into consideration the rural areas that that community serves you still would have much higher concentration than you would in a large city, but let me go to the next point and why, why do we need to override, in effect, override and maybe you have discussed this before but override the zoning abilities or prerogatives of local municipal government.

SENATOR SIECK: Okay, too many times in a given area the citizens will not accept people of this type. They have a lot more power than an individual of this nature. They will be overruled in every instance. I feel that we need to protect these people, that is really what the basic point is.

SENATOR LAMB: I guess I'm not sure that is true because in some of the towns that I represent those homes have been established without this legislation. So I'm not sure that that is completely true and I guess I hesitate to continue to erode the local control that we are always talking about that is so important to our form of government.

SENATOR SIECK: As you look at the list I see many, many homes out there in the rural sector. In some of the cities are even more than those that are defined by the law. I think that this can continue on. It wouldn't necessarily have to hold that limit down, but if it goes over that limit and there were a lot of city councils out there, city government's that were concerned that we would just put to many homes like this so that is the reason we limit it to a certain area. So many homes then it would have to have a variance from the city council to have more.

SENATOR LAMB: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: All right, the question then is, Senator Sieck, that then concludes, you have no close?

SENATOR SIECK: No closing, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: All right, the question then is the advancement of LB 525 as amended. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Have you voted? Motion to advance LB 525 to E & R Initial. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, no nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries, LB 525 advances to E & R Initial. Anything on the desk to be read in, Mr. Clerk?
