SENATOR KOCH: We will have to ask for a Call of the House, Mr. Speaker. I am rather reluctant to do that. If Senator Vickers would vote for it we would be all right.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay on the adoption of Senator Koch's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The amendments are adopted and before we proceed with the bill, underneath the south balcony from Senator Wagner's district it is my privilege to introduce Mr. and Mrs. Henry Lange from Ord. Would you please stand? Okay, now are we ready for the bill, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir. I have nothing further on the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, I move the bill be advanced as amended.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of the bill as amended. Senator Lamb, do you wish to speak to the motion?

SENATOR LAMB: Senator Koch, could you explain again what your amendment does?

SENATOR KOCH: Yes, Senator. Senator Lamb, what was your question, I'm sorry, I didn't hear it.

SENATOR LAMB: What does your amendment do?

SENATOR KOCH: Well what it does, it...originally we were only talking about the National Guard. We have added the active select Reserve as well and then we prescribe as you can see there, "the college and University will compile a record of the total dollar amount of the tuition credits granted for the academic year. At the completion of the academic year, the college or university shall submit the total to the agency for the amount of tuition which is due them." I think originally we had in there, every thirty days and then we amended it to say annually it shall be done, not on a thirty-day basis.

SENATOR LAMB: Okay, does this ... now does this change the final place where the responsibility for the funding lies?
