PRESIDENT: We are going to pass over the Resolution 179 temporarily at least because there are some people not present that would certainly want to discuss it, and so we will go on to LR 185, Senator Clark. Mr. Clerk, if you will read LR 185. Senator Clark, we are going to take up 185...LR 185 at this time.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 185 was offered by Senator Clark. It is found on page 222 of the Legislative Journal. (Read LR 185.)

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: Mr. President and members, I hope you would pay attention to this resolution. The Educational Lands and Funds Board, part of them, are going back to Washington Sunday and they are going to present this resolution back there and I would hope we would have unanimity on it. What really happened was, when they had the Sioux Army Depot at Sidney, Nebraska this federal government condemned this land in fee simple. They only needed the surface rights but they took all of the rights. Now I am not asking for any rights for the individual owners out there, but there are two sections within that depot that were owned by the state of Nebraska on the school lands. One of those school lands has been developed in oil now and there is approximately two million dollars been taken out of it. We are asking that the federal government returns that to the state of Nebraska to the school lands. This affects all of you. It does not affect
