CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Rumery moves to withdraw LB 638. The motion was offered yesterday and is laid over a day as required by the rules.

PRESIDENT: Senator Rumery.

SENATOR RUMERY: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, we have found some mistakes in this bill so we want to get the unanimous consent to withdraw it and we will have another one printed in its place.

PRESIDENT: All right. You need a vote on it so I will take that as your motion, Senator Rumery, to...

SENATOR RUMERY: I so move.

PRESIDENT: ...move to withdraw LB 638. Any discussion? If not, all those in favor of the motion to withdraw LB 638 vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to withdraw the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries and LB 638 is withdrawn. Next we will move to...all right, the Clerk has a couple of matters to read into the record. Proceed.
