SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance LB 184 to E & R for review as amended. Is there any further discussion? All those in favor vote aye, opposed no, the advancement of the bill. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried, the bill is advanced. The Clerk has some items to read into the record.
