SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record your presence please. Record.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Newell, are you ready to take up LB 483?

SENATOR NEWELL: This is the old hard choice. There is not many people here.

SPEAKER MARVEL: There are several underneath the balcony.

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, is it possible, if I do not take it up this time, it goes on the "passed over" file.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes.

SENATOR NEWELL: Could it be brought up.....yes. Let's take it.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You want to proceed.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 483, read title. The bill was first read on January 17, 1979. It was referred to Senator Nichol's Judiciary Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending by Senator Nichol's Judiciary Committee, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: While we are waiting for the discussion of the committee amendments, I would call your attention, the white sheet that was placed on your desk this morning is a General File list that will follow what we are doing now. It starts with LB 507 so you might take a look at those, as we proceed from LB 483 to LB 507 and then on down the line. Senator Nichol, are you ready on the committee amendments?

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature, the committee amendments to LB 483 completely rewrite the bill. Senator Newell brought these amendments to the committee and he should handle these on the floor since they do become the entire legislation.
