SPEAKER MARVEL: One minute, Senator Lewis.

SENATOR LEWIS: ...for ID purposes. That will become a significant fine. For those that procure liquor for a minor a mandatory jail sentence. That is how you will get at the law. You won't get it by trying to do something here that sounds good and looks bad, and this does look bad unless we try to make some reasonable exceptions in terms of the circumstances of the districts. Sometimes I think this is a prohibition fight, and if it is it ought to be approached in a straightforward method on those for alcohol and those without, and many of us could then do what many Oklahoma politicians did for years to get elected. They would say that I am politically dry and personally wet.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: I call the question.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? I see five hands. The question is, shall debate now close? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 4 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Debate ceases. The Chair recognizes Senator Dworak to close on the Hoagland-Dworak-Wagner amendment.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. Speaker, fellow Nebraskans, I commend Senator Kelly, I commend all the Senators on the floor for the efforts they have made on this very difficult issue. Regardless of what position you have taken, either for or against, I know each of you personally have spent many hours, much time, much anguish, thinking about this decision. It is one of those complicated issues that isn't absolute. We can't go to statistics and find absolute proof. There is no place...there is no book, there is no bank of knowledge, there is no scientific evidence where we can go to absolutely assure ourselves in our mind what we do today is right or wrong, whether we are going to hurt more people or whether we are going to help more people by the actions we take. We have a problem. I would be the first to admit it. Senator Kelly has told us it is a moral issue, and I firmly believe you cannot legislate morality. Morality cannot be legislated. We have a problem with the trickle-down effect whereby 18, 17, 16,
