SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

SPEAKER MARVEL: We almost have a quorum.

CLERK: Senator Labeledz would like to be excused until she arrives, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The first bill on the agenda this afternoon is General File LB 533, which has to do with retirement.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 533 was introduced by the Retirement Systems Committee. (Read title to LB 533.) The bill was read on January 17 of last year. It was referred to the Retirement Systems Committee for public hearing. It was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending, Mr. President. Senator Fowler has amendments to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you have committee amendments? Senator Fowler.

SENATOR FOWLER: I would move this amendment to the committee amendment. It strikes one of the sections of the committee amendment that dealt with changes in retirement for judges as far as the age of retirement and the term, to allow basically a judge who was nearing the retirement age to serve out the term. Since then that judge is deceased and I think the committee felt that the amendment therefore was no longer necessary. The particular circumstance for that amendment no longer exists. So I would move the adoption of that amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there a second to the motion? Okay. Any further discussion? This is a deletion of an amendment, Senator Fowler, is that right? Okay, the motion is to strike the amendment to LB 533. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Okay, Clerk record the vote.

CLERK: 13 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President on adoption of the amendment.
