PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Wesely. Senator Nichol...on the, speaking to the amendment now. I think I should just explain to the Legislature, I think most of you know this, but if this motion carries this matter immediately goes to the committee and that is it. So there will be no further discussion, so go ahead.

SENATOR NICHOL: I call for the question, your honor.

PRESIDENT: All right, with that in mind you call for the question. Do I see five hands? I do. The question then is, shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. Debate ceases. Senator Venditte, to close on your amendment.

SENATOR VENDITTE: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, what the amendment does is just simply refers this resolution to the Executive Board for interim study, and I think that perhaps during an interim study it just simply allows the people of this state to lend some support to what they feel or what we feel might be an energy conservation program. I think we could at least do that and it would seem incumbent on everyone of us in here that we ought to start getting some public input, and I think it is important at this time and hopefully you will support to at least send this resolution to the Executive Board for an interim study.

PRESIDENT: The question is the adoption of the Venditte amendment to LR 186. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay.
