PRESIDENT: While the Legislature is in session and capable of doing business I propose to sign and I do sign LR 188. Before we get involved on the agenda, in taking up agenda item #5, the Chair would like to introduce some guests of Senator Cullan, thirteen members of the women's basketball team from Chadron State College. They are up here in the North balcony with Marge Burkett their coach. Would the team from Chadron please stand up and be recognized. The Legislature greets you this morning. Welcome to your Legislature. We will now proceed with agenda item #5, General File, commencing with LB 35, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 35 was introduced by Senator Johnson of the 35th District. (Read title.) The bill was first read on January 4, 1979. It was referred to the Public Health Committee for public hearing. It was advanced to General File with the committee amendments attached. The committee amendments were adopted by the body on April 26 of last year. In addition there was an amendment by Senator...apparently I have an amendment pending by Senator Johnson, Mr. President. The amendment was distributed this year. It was printed in the Journal, page 1204.

SENATOR JOHNSON: Is that the amendment from last year that was printed?

CLERK: Yes.

SENATOR JOHNSON: Yes, all right, I would like to have unanimous consent to withdraw that amendment and substitute another which you have in your materials.

PRESIDENT: So the Chair understands the amendment that was pending is now withdrawn.

SENATOR JOHNSON: That is correct.

PRESIDENT: And Senator Johnson is submitting another amendment.

SENATOR JOHNSON: That is correct and the Clerk has that amendment and I am now having it distributed to the members.

PRESIDENT: Has the amendment been distributed, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Yes.

SENATOR JOHNSON: It is in the process of being distributed now.
