SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes, go ahead with Select File.

PRESIDENT: The Chair will advise you that we will now proceed with agenda item #7 on Select File and the following bills have amendments filed so we are going to take all the rest of them first. Now the very first bill, LB 525, has an amendment filed. LB 436 has an amendment filed. That is a constitutional amendment. LB 235 has one and 185 so we will start with LB 203 and go on down the line. The rest of them do not have amendments other than the E & R amendments. So commence then, Senator Wesely with LB 203.

SENATOR WESELY: Are there E & R amendments?

CLERK: There are no E & R amendments on this one, Senator.

SENATOR WESELY: Then I move that LB 203 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB 203 to E & R for engrossment. Is there any discussion? All those in favor of advancing LB 203 to E & R for engrossment signify by saying aye, opposed nay. LB 203 is advanced to E & R for engrossment. LB 572 also has no amendments.

SENATOR WESELY: I move that LB 572 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB 572 to E & R for engrossment. Any discussion? If not, all those in favor signify by saying aye, opposed nay. LB 572 is advanced to E & R for engrossment. Same goes for LB 442, Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. President, I move that LB 442 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB 442 to E & R for engrossment. Is there any discussion? All those in favor signify by saying aye, opposed nay. LB 442 is advanced to E & R for engrossment. Now the next series of bills have E & R amendments. Is that right, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir, they do.

PRESIDENT: All right, from here on down through 108.

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, I am ready on these.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Wesely, go ahead.
