LB 499, 828

PRESIDENT: Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 6 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: So we will go then, Mr. Speaker, to the agenda item #5...

SPEAKER MARVEL: Withdrawal of two bills.

PRESIDENT: On motions. Before we do we would like to introduce from Senator Pirsch's district sitting under the south balcony, Mr. Kent Lush from Omaha District 10.
