

PRESIDENT: All right, it went into my thinking, Senator Dworak, as to why I made the decision I made, so I have a right to say that at this time since I made the decision and that is why I made it. So now I am going to call the question of, shall the Chair be overruled. Twenty-five. That's all. Okay, the question is, shall the Chair be overruled? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, there are seventeen people not voting and I would like a Call of the House, please, and a roll call vote so that we can get this issue solved.

PRESIDENT: All right. Okay, Senator, the motion then is, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote on the Call of the House.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 7 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The House is under Call. The Sergeant at Arms will clear the floor, bring in all the members of the Legislature. They shall return to their desks and all legislators will register your presence, please. Senator DeCamp, would you show us you are here? Show us you are present here. Senator Marsh, I know you are here. Senator Haberman and Senator Kelly, I know you are all here. Senator George, Senator Lewis, Senator Fitzgerald and Senator Simon are the only ones excused. The Sergeant at Arms will note that all the rest of the members shall be at their desks, except Senator George, Senator Lewis, Senator Fitzgerald and Senator Simon. The question is, shall the Chair be overruled on the motion to cease debate...I...the Chair ruled ceasing debate...I've almost got to go back and get a score card to see who the players are and what the plays are. It is a Dworak amendment to LB 499 and there was only...Senator Dworak spoke. Senator Koch made a motion to cease debate. The Chair was asked to rule under the new rule that not enough people had debated and I said that enough people had... the subject had come up enough so I ruled that the debate ceases, and now the motion is to...yes, now Senator Dworak, do you want to have call-in votes at this time?

SENATOR DWORAK: Who is not accounted for yet, Mr. President?

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers and Senator Kelly. I think Senator Kelly was right over...there he is. Yes, just push the button and then we will know you are here. Okay. Now it is just Senator Chambers, I guess.
