

the debate so far in the last five, eight, ten, twelve minutes, I think the issue has been somewhat clouded. The fact of the matter is that we have certain neighborhoods within the City of Omaha right now that are oversaturated with these kinds of homes. Well, it was subsequent to that kind of action by these group home facilities that the City of Omaha thought an ordinance to protect the communities within the city to be in the best interest of the people of the city. So the City of Omaha went ahead and they drafted ordinances to protect the community, to protect the neighborhoods from this oversaturation of group care facilities. Now, they have had a great deal of input as a result of the ordinances that have been written in the City of Omaha from people at large. Now subsequent to the passage of this legislation, no longer, no longer do the citizens of the City of Omaha have the voice, have the voice that they once had. We are taking that, Senator Sleck, completely away from them and that I think, ladies and gentlemen, is what is bad about the bill. The good thing about the amendment that is coming back to us this morning from E & R Final is that at least it will maintain the voice of the people. If they want these group care facilities, then I think it should be up to them, not up to the Legislature. So with that, Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, I would hope that you would support the Venditte amendment and bring the bill back to Select File for that specific amendment. To save time, I will ask for a Call of the House. I see many of the Douglas County delegation not within the immediate o ding area so I would ask for a Call of the House and a roll call vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record.
