LB 526

SENATOR KOCH: So move.

PRESIDENT: Motion to readvance LB 526 to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor signify by saying aye, opposed nay. LB 526 is readvanced to E & R for engrossing. Now, Mr. Clerk, take up the second Koch amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Koch now moves to return LB 526 to Select File for specific amendment. Read Koch amendment as found on page 468, Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Thank you, Mr. President. This is a technical change. Before in the bill, we had the word "year" in there. Now we are substituting the word "term". That is more appropriate to the postsecondary colleges and to the community colleges and to the university and it just means that at the end of the term the University, the college or the tech college will notify the Guard that this number of students have completed their work and this is the amount of tuition which is due them. That is what the amendment does and I move for the adoption or I move for the return of 526 and the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: All right, the motion is to return LB 526 for that specific amendment as explained by Senator Koch. Any discussion? If not, the question then is the return of LB 526 for that amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. The bill is returned for the specific amendment and the question now is the specific amendment. Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. President, I move for the adoption of the specific amendment to 526.

PRESIDENT: The motion is...any further discussion? All right. All those in favor of adopting this specific amendment as explained by Senator Koch vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? We are voting on the specific amendment. Have you all voted? Record the vote?

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Koch's amendment.
