LB 306, 284

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB 284 to E & R for Engrossment. All those in favor signify by saying aye. Opposed nay. LB 284 is advanced to E & R for Engrossment. Next we will have LB 306. We will take just a moment. We will then continue with LB 306. Mr. Clerk, do you want to bring us up on the status of this one? 306.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 306 has E & R amendments pending.

PRESIDENT: Senator Stoney. All right, Senator Beutler. Where is Senator Beutler? Senator Lewis, would you move to adopt the E & R amendments on LB 306 so we can get going here?

SENATOR LEWIS: Mr. Chairman, as the new E & R Committee Chairman, I move that we adopt the amendments, the E & R amendments.

PRESIDENT: All right, the motion is to adopt the E & R amendments on LB 306. Any discussion? All those in favor of adopting the E & R amendments to LB 306 signify by voting aye. All those opposed nay. The E & R amendments are adopted. Now, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Landis now has amendments pending and they are found on page 390 of the Legislative Journal. There is a note that he wishes to withdraw. Is that accurate, Senator?

PRESIDENT: Senator Lamb (sic) is that...

CLERK: That's Senator Landis.

PRESIDENT: Landis...oh, Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS:they be withdrawn.

PRESIDENT: Senator Landis wishes to withdraw them. All right, they are withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have an amendment offered by Senator Hoagland, Marsh and Pirsch. (Read amendment as found on page 468 of the Legislative Journal.) Mr. President, that amendment is offered by Senators Hoagland, Marsh and Pirsch.
