PRESIDENT: Well, you can't do it after you have debated. Senator Vickers. Senator Vickers will call the question. I hate to...well, let's see, Senator DeCamp, you didn't want to talk, did you? All right, well there won't be any need for ceasing debate because, Senator Vickers, you were the last one on, so save it for the next time. So we will let...Senator Chambers, you may close on your...no close. So then motion before the House is the adoption of the Chambers' amendment to LB 306. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 2 nays on adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The amendment is adopted. Any further amendments on the desk, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Beutler, do you want to move the bill again, or whatever...

SENATOR BEUTLER: I move that the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance to E & R for Engrossment. All those in favor signify by saying aye. Opposed nay. Machine vote. All right, machine vote has been requested. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote nay. Vote on the machine. We are voting on the advancement of LB 306.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, I think we ought to have a Call of the House and roll call vote, please.

PRESIDENT: All right, motion...record what is on the board, and we will go to the motion to have a Call of the House. All those in favor of a Call of the House vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 24 ayes, 0 nays to under Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The House is under Call. All members will return to their seats. All nonlegislative personnel will leave. All members at their desks will register their presence. Senator Beutler, I believe, had in his motion a roll call vote, but do you want to accept votes, or... call-in votes or not? All right, he said to go ahead and accept call-in votes? All right.

CLERK: Senator George voting aye. Senator Kahle changing
