Machine vote has been requested. Machine vote. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Senator Newell, do you want to bring them in?

SENATOR NEWELL: I am going to have to and then, sometimes, it is my bill and I would like to maybe move the advancement myself. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Okay. The motion then is, shall the House go under Call? Record the vote on the Board. The motion is, shall the House go under Call. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed nay. Senator Newell, normally on Select File, the E & R Chairman moves these bills ahead but that is all right. We don't have an E & R Chairman. Hey, he is here now.

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, I would like to take in some call in votes if that is....

PRESIDENT: We will record the vote here first.

CLERK: 24 ayes, 2 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The House is under Call. The Sergeant at Arms will secure all members in the Chamber. All members will return to their desks. All nonauthorized personnel will leave the floor. The House is under Call. All members will register your presence. Senator Newell, you do want to accept call ins?

SENATOR NEWELL: Please.

PRESIDENT: All right. Mr. Clerk, you may go ahead.

CLERK: Senator Wagner voting aye. Senator Fowler voting aye. Senator Wesely voting aye. Senator Venditte changing from no to yes.

PRESIDENT: Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 13 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries and LB 483 is advanced to E & R for engrossment. Motion has been made by Senator Rumery to raise the Call. The Call is raised. Go on to the next bill, Mr. Clerk, LB 185.

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, there are no E & R amendments
