

CLERK: Rule 7, Section 3.

PRESIDENT: ...7, Section 3...the motion is to suspend the rule and take up this matter of the indefinite postponement of LR 30 today. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. It will require thirty votes. Three are absent, Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: I will ask for a Call of the House, Mr. Chairman.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Lamb. Clear the board and the motion then is, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 1 nay to go under Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The House is under Call. The Sergeant at Arms will secure all members. They shall return to their desks. All unauthorized personnel will leave the floor of the Legislature and all members will register their presence. The House is under Call. Senator Lamb, did you want to accept calls, or do you want to go to a roll call when they all get here? You will accept calls. Senator Lamb will accept call-ins. For those who are coming in, the question is, the House is under Call, to vote for a suspension of the rules to take up an indefinite postponement motion on LR 30.

CLERK: Senator Warner voting aye. Senator Schmit voting aye. Senator DeCamp voting aye. Senator Dworak voting aye. Senator Kahle voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Senator Newell. Senator Newell, will you show us you are here? Thank you. Senator Koch, are you...yes. Senator Koch, will you show us you are here? Senator Kahle, will you turn your light on? Senator Merz, could you come out from behind the paper long enough to push the button? Thank you. The House is under Call. Senator Haberman, no politickin'. Let's say it before they say it. Senator Koch.

CLERK: Senator Koch voting...continues to vote no. Senator Goodrich voting aye. Senator Kelly voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kelly, do you want to push the button to show you are here? Thank you.

CLERK: Senator Maresh changing from no to yes.

PRESIDENT: Record the vote.
