LB 388, 481, 499, 525, 742.

PRESIDENT: Yes, sir.

SENATOR DeCAMP: ...a Call of the House, roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: All right, record the board and all those in favor of a Call of the House vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The House is under Call once again, and the Sergeant at Arms once again will go and fetch all the legislators who are not here, and once again all legislators will return to their desks and once again will you register your presence. Those remarks are not facetious. They are made seriously. Let's go over those that are there that haven't registered your presence. Senator Marsh, Senator Dworak, Senator Chronister, Senator Newell, Senator Merz, Senator Newell, yes, all right, Senator Newell...we are waiting on Newell. Five are excused so we are down to Senator...if we can get Senator Newell here we are ready to go. Do you want a roll call vote now? Do you want to wait for Newell? Senator DeCamp, do you want to wait for Senator Newell? Do you want to wait? Okay, we can wait. We have waited a long time...we can wait some more. He is here. All right, Senator Newell is here. Senator DeCamp, you...roll call vote. Motion is, shall LB 499 be advanced to E & R Initial? All those in favor aye, opposed nay, and a roll call vote.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote as found on page 491 of the Legislative Journal.) 21 ayes, 23 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. The bill does not advance. The next bill on General File is LB 481, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I may briefly, Mr. President, your committee on Business and Labor gives notice of public hearing in room 1019. (See page 491 of the Journal.) Senator DeCamp would like to print amendments to LB 388. (See page 492 of the Legislative Journal.) Administrative Rules gives notice of public hearing. (See page 492 of the Journal.) Your committee on Revenue whose Chairman is Senator Carsten to whom was referred LB 742 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File. (See pages 492 and 493 of the Journal.) Senator Chambers would like to print some material in the Legislative Journal, Mr. President.
