Senator Fitzgerald would like to print amendments to LB 184 in the Legislative Journal.

Mr. President, I have a communication and an enclosed resolution from the Executive Committee of the National Association of State Treasurers. That will be on file in my office.

Mr. President, the Committee on Committees gives notice of cancellation of public hearings.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is that all? Senator Goodrich, do you want to bring up LB 442? You have got a motion to bring it back?

SENATOR GOODRICH: Yes. Mr. President and members of the body, LB 442 is on Final Reading today and LB 442 is a bill, it is a carryover bill, in other words, and in going from one session to the next session like this, we forgot to change a date in the bill. So the amendment that I am asking you to bring it back for is to just change 1979 to 1980 on page 3, line 13, which is a minor thing but we have got to do it so I am moving that we return LB 442 for a specific amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is to return LB 442 to Select File for a specific amendment. Is there any discussion? All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is returned. Senator Goodrich, do you move the adoption?

SENATOR GOODRICH: Hello! Okay, can we just take up, can we take up the amendment later. We have got it back now. Now we just take up this amendment later? Can we do that later? The reason is, Senator Beutler and I are working on the form of the amendment and he would like to add more to it.

SPEAKER MARVEL: No, we have to adopt the specific amendment for which the bill was returned.

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
