LB 597

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, are we reading LB 597?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes, sir.

SENATOR NICHOL: I believe we had a motion up there to bring that back for an amendment. There was a typographical error where we left out the word "double" and it should be erased so that it would jibe with the first part of the bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Nichol moves to return LB 597 to Select File for specific amendment. The amendment is found on page 487 of the Legislative Journal.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, Judge Fahrnbruch asked me...

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, Judge Fahrnbruch suggested that we bring this back first of all to have the word "double" stricken in the latter part of the bill so it would match the forepart of the bill where the word "double" was stricken. Secondly, on page 4, to insert "demonstrating reasonable cause", to be inserted on line 6 after the word "facts". It doesn't change the meaning of the bill and the word "double" should be coinciding with the first part of the bill so I move for the bringing back of LB 597 to E & R Engrossing for this amendment. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You have heard the motion. Is there any other discussion? All those in favor of returning 597 to Select File for a specific amendment vote aye, opposed no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is returned. Now, Senator Nichol, you move the adoption of the amendment?

SENATOR NICHOL: Yes, Mr. Chairman, I move for the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there any discussion? All those in favor of the adoption of the Nichol amendment to LB 597 vote aye, opposed no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.
