LB 409, 525

CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 515, Legislative Journal.) 42 ayes, 0 nays, 7 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed. Senator Sieck moves that LB 525 be returned to Select File for a specific amendment. The Clerk will read the amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, the amendment reads as follows: Read Sieck amendment found on page 516, Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Sieck.

SENATOR SIECK: This is very difficult for me to have my bill come back but in visiting with the Omaha delegation I find that the intent that I intended to have they didn't feel was in there and that is that the group homes would be all either twelve hundred feet or one-half mile from existing homes and all this does is clarify the intent that I originally intended to do. I urge your support for this amendment. The real reason is to satisfy the Omaha delegation that has several different types of group homes so that they know that they will be divided equally with any other group home. I move for the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to return the bill to Select File for specific amendment. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is returned. Senator Sieck moves the adoption of the amendment. Is there any further discussion? All those in favor of the adoption of the Sieck amendment vote aye, opposed no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendment is adopted. Now, Senator Sieck moves to return the bill to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR SIECK: I move we return the bill for E & R engrossment.
