

the boiler house is not part of the package or does not deny service to Douglas County facilities, it just says that the state should receive fair compensation and it should not be a controversial amendment I would hope.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there any further discussion on the amendment? The motion is the adoption of the Wesely amendment to LB 184. All in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendment is adopted. Do you have another amendment?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Mr. President, Senator Wesely moves to amend: (Read second Wesely amendment to LB 184 as found on page 538 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, again I would hope that this amendment is not that controversial, because it basically reflects what the arrangement has been made concerning this bill. We have talked about on this Douglas County Veterans' Home proposal that it is being offered to the state at a \$1.00 a year lease, and that this is a special bargain for the state, and that this is a real opportunity that we should take advantage of. Well, I take them at their word and believe that if that is the case, if we are talking about a \$1.00 a year lease arrangement, then let's put it in the law, let's make it clear that at a \$1.00 a year lease then the state of Nebraska can proceed with an arrangement with Douglas County and proceed with the development of that annex into a veterans' home for the state, but that, if in fact that \$1.00 a year lease proposal that we have been talking about is going to be changed for whatever reasons and I take Douglas County at their word that it won't change but if it is just possible that some time down the road, maybe not this year, maybe not next year, but some time down the road that lease may change and Douglas County may charge us a much greater amount to have that annex and that facility, and this just says, let's take them at their word, let's leave it at a \$1.00 a year lease, and then let's proceed in that fashion. So, I don't see much problem with this amendment, I would hope.
