SENATOR MARSH: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Madam Speaker, this is the very amendment, or the compromise that Senator Koch has spoken of which I do agree with in the sense that I think this matter should go on its way now. I do not agree in principle necessarily with what is being done. Thank you.

SENATOR MARSH: Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Madam Chairman, I have no objection to the amendment as it is written now, thank you.

SENATOR MARSH: We are now ready and will vote upon the return of LB 442 for specific amendment. Senator Marsh voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Marsh voting aye.

SENATOR MARSH: The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return.

SENATOR MARSH: The motion is adopted. Senator Beutler, what will you do with the bill? Excuse me...now we are ready to adopt the amendment. We are voting on the adoption of the amendment. Senator Marsh voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Marsh voting aye.

SENATOR MARSH: The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

SENATOR MARSH: Senator Beutler, do you move for readvancement?

SENATOR BEUTLER: I would so move, Madam Speaker.

SENATOR MARSH: All those in favor signify by saying aye for the readvancement of 442? Opposed. It is advanced. We will now move to LB 607.

CLERK: Madam Chair, LB 607 was introduced by Senator Nelson Merz of the 1st Legislative District. (Read title to LB 607.) The bill was read on January 9 of this year. It was referred to the Government Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. There are no amendments
