CLERK: 26 ayes, 12 nays on adoption of Senator DeCamp's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. Are there any other amendments to 658?

SENATOR STONEY: Senator Beutler, just for my edification, I noticed that the bill states that the county board may appoint suitable persons. What qualifications or credentials do these people have that would act as referees?

SENATOR BEUTLER: To my knowledge, Senator Stoney, there is nothing set out in the statutes as to what their qualifications have to be, to my knowledge. Certainly I think you would want somebody experienced in real estate. That would be, in my opinion, far and away the most important criteria.

SENATOR STONEY: So from your knowledge generally that is the criteria that is established that the individual have knowledge, general knowledge, in real estate here in the State of Nebraska.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes, I don't know that it is set out anywhere in the statutes, any criteria. I will check that for you.
