SPEAKER MARVEL: The question is shall the House go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators please take your seats, record your presence. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Those of you who wish to have your vote recorded can call it in to the Chair, or to the Clerk. Senator Warner, Senator Keyes, Senator Schmit, Senator Rumery, Senator Kremer, Senator Merz.

CLERK: Senator Fitzgerald voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Fitzgerald, will you record your presence? Senator Wagner. For what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR BEUTLER: I changed my mind, I want a roll call vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Fitzgerald, you still are not recorded as present. Senator Chambers, Senator Cullan, Senator Labeledz. Senator Vickers, would you... Senator Beutler, Senator Chambers is the only one who is not recorded in. Do you want to proceed with a roll call vote?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Pardon me, I am sorry, I didn't hear you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All are accounted for except Senator Chambers. Do you wish to proceed?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Proceed.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, call the roll. All legislators please be in your seats. Hold the roll call until we all get in our seats. Senator Chambers, the vote is on the advancement of 658. Okay, proceed with the roll call vote.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote as found on page 543 of the Legislative Journal.) 28 ayes, 14 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Senator Keyes wishes to have an Exec Session of the Government Committee underneath the south balcony. How much do you have to read in? Well, why don't you go ahead and read them in and then we will take up at least one other bill.
