CLERK: Well we are now discussing Request 2037 as amended, Senator.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Johnson, do you wish to be recognized? Okay, Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Do you have another amendment, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Senator, the one we just adopted was the amendment to Request #2037 and now we are discussing 2037 as amended.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Okay. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I think that the bill has been fairly well explained. I think we know what we are doing. I think that we really want to try to do something that is going to be helpful in the area of employment for inmates and I think we are trying to encourage the gainful education and employment of these individuals. We are also trying to make it more practical and possible for the Crime Victims Reparation Board to carry out their responsibilities. I think that these amendments will enhance those responsibilities and opportunities and I would suggest that if there are any questions I would like to answer them but otherwise I would move the advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of 2037 as amended. Senator Kremer, do you wish to speak to the... Okay. The motion now is on the amendment to 2037 as amended. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. We are on LB 319. We are on the amended version of 2037. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the Schmit amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion now is the advancement of the bill. Senator Kremer, do you wish to speak to that motion?

SENATOR KREMER: Senator Schmit, would you respond to a question or two?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Yes, I will, Senator.

SENATOR KREMER: Senator Schmit, I am making reference to #2 on your explanation of the bill, encourage the department to establish farms, both to provide food and employment opportunities. What I would like to know is do the facilities,

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
