SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. The Clerk has one more amendment to read before the time is up.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schmit had amendments on page 414 and I understand he wishes to withdraw those.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay.

CLERK: Senator DeCamp now moves to indefinitely postpone the bill.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, since we are running out of time, I will be very brief. All you opponents of branch banking, all you proclaimers of opposition to branching with the Wesely amendment just opened wide-open branch banking, citywide branch banking. That is what you did.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the indefinite postponement of LB 491. Clear the Board, Mr. Clerk. All those in favor of indefinite postponement vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: A point of order, Mr. Chairman. I thought we voted on this the other day. Isn't this the same subject, the same issue?

SPEAKER MARVEL: It is not a reconsideration, Senator Hefner, because we have amended the bill since the previous motion.

SENATOR HEFNER: Okay.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, record the vote.

CLERK: 13 ayes, 23 nays on the motion to indefinitely postpone, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion fails.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, I suppose we take a vote on advancing it now, is that correct?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Go ahead.
