SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Vickers amendment to 628. All in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. As soon as we take the vote, this will end the discussion on this bill for today. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Vickers.

SENATOR VICKERS: Well, I hesitate to but I think we are going to have to have a Call of the House, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question before the House is shall the House go under Call? All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators please take their seats, unauthorized personnel leave the floor, record your presence. Senator Kennedy, Senator George, Senator Keyes, Senator Fowler, Senator Beutler, Senator Kremer, Senator Merz, Senator DeCamp, Senator Dworak, Senator Haberman, Senator Simon, Senator Lewis, Senator Labeledz. Mr. Sergeant at Arms, Senator DeCamp, Senator L bedz, Senator Simon. The House is under Call. All legislators please be in their seats, the House is under Call. Senator Vickers, there are only two unaccounted for, do you want to proceed?

SENATOR VICKERS: Yes, let's have a roll call vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay. All legislators please be in their seats before we start the roll call. Call the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote. (See page 589, Legislative Journal.) 18 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to adopt.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. Debate ceases on this bill. The Clerk will read.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner gives notice of a room change for purposes of a public hearing.

Your committee on Education whose Chairman is Senator Koch to whom we referred LB 773 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File with amendments; LB 426 indefinitely postponed.
