SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor of adopting the committee amendments vote aye, opposed no.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The committee amendments are adopted.

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. Speaker, I move for the advancement of LB 602 as amended.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Kahle, your light was on, do you wish to speak to the advancement?

SENATOR KAHLE: Mr. Speaker, this is probably a little facetious but I wondered if this water main was carrying water from the Platte Valley. If it is, if the law that controls transbasin diversion applies?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: No, sir, it is not. Thank you, Senator Kahle.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of 602 to E & R for review as amended. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. The next bill is 645.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 645, title read. The bill was read on January 9 of this year. It was referred to the Urban Affairs Committee for public hearing. It was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending by Senator George's Urban Affairs Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: LB 645, Senator George.

SENATOR GEORGE: Again, Mr. President, the committee amendments are the bill so I will refer that again to Senator Nichol.
