PRESIDENT: Ready for agenda item #5, reports, and Committee on Committee reports. The Chair recognizes Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: What page?

CLERK: Page 582, 583, Senator.

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, the Committee on Committees desires to report favorably upon the appointments or reappointments listed below: John M. Gradwohl, Judge, Commission of Industrial Relations; Doris Royal, Agricultural Products Industrial Utilization Committee; Hal Schroeder, Environmental Control Council; and Richard Veach, Environmental Control Council.
