SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: Yes, Senator Vickers.

SENATOR VICKERS: Yes, Senator Keyes, it seems to me that last session, as a matter of fact, I introduced a bill for the county officials also that dealt with basically this same subject, and if I remember correctly, if my memory serves me right, the bill had to do with the date that political subdivisions supplied the budget to the county commissioners. The intent at that time, again if I remember correctly, was that if they supplied the budget a little bit earlier, their budgets, then it would allow the commissioners a little additional time to levy the mill levy...to figure the mill levy. I thought that all the problems were solved with that bill a year ago and if you can enlighten me as to what has taken place in the meantime, why I would appreciate it.

SENATOR KEYES: Well, I was in on that bill and I also remember that we did set it to take care of the county, but they seem to feel that because I suppose of this every other year or every year re-evaluation thing that they just need the extra fifteen days and they feel that there is no way that you can add fifteen days to the year so when you advance this or set this back fifteen days the other subdivisions of government that depend on that to set the mill levy, we hope they can get it in in time. I am not an authority on it, I just know that that is what Jack Mills asked and he said there is no opposition in the counties, so...

SENATOR VICKERS: Well, thank you, Senator Keyes. I guess it just upsets me a little bit when I thought we had an agreement worked out a year ago that if we set this date, well, we are going to be happy with it and then we won't be back here every year to bug this body about a few days, ten, fifteen, twenty, whatever the days might be, and it upsets me a little bit that they at least can't live with it with the agreement that they reached with us a year ago for any more than one year at a time. Thank you.
