SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 857. Senator Cope.

SENATOR COPE: Mr. President and members, a question of Senator Vickers.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Vickers.

SENATOR COPE: Senator Vickers, I notice that there is ten days given notice. I presume that is to people whose land would have this type of installation on. Is ten days enough time? Those are the committee amendments now.

SENATOR VICKERS: I knew you would do this...somebody would do this to me because I hadn't even looked at this before... since the hearing.

SENATOR COPE: Well, I just...

SENATOR VICKERS: But I think, Ron, what we are dealing with here, Senator Cope, I don't think we are dealing with the owners of land. I think we are simply dealing with other entities that also own the microwave facilities, the regulated carrier or carriers involved, and not landowners, not any private individuals.

SENATOR COPE: Well, let me look at it further too, and then if...more questions at the next stop because I saw the ten days and that...I interpreted that as to the owners and I didn't think that would be sufficient time for something as important as this is the reason I questioned it.

SENATOR VICKERS: I am sure that this is the regulated carrier or carriers involved.

SENATOR COPE: Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Kremer, do you want to comment Senator Cope's question? On...Senator Cope, do you want to repeat your question to Senator Kremer? Did you get an answer to it or do you want to...are we ready for the adoption of the committee amendments, Senator Vickers? The motion is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 857. All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the adoption of the committee amendments to 857. Have you all voted? Record.
