Your committee on Ag and Environment whose Chairman is Senator Schmit to whom we referred LB 833 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File. That is signed by Senator Schmit.

Your committee on Constitutional Revision and Recreation whose Chairman is Senator Reutzel to whom we referred LB 82 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File with amendments. That is signed by Senator Reutzel.

SPEAKER MARVEL: LB 701A.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 701, title read.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Kremer, 701A.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature, 701A is the A bill for 701. It increased the per diem allowance for the Natural Resource Commission members to \$50. That is all the bill does.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Any further discussion? Senator Keyes. Excuse me.

SENATOR KREMER: I think the figure given to me at least would be about \$15,000. That would be the A bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: \$50,000?

SENATOR KREMER: \$15,000, fifteen.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Keyes and then Senator Schmit. 701A.

SENATOR KEYES: Mr. Speaker, 701A breaks from what the Governor and the rest of the Legislature here basically has had in mind this year and that is that we are going to live within a seven percent increase in the budget as good, as close as Senator Warner and the Appropriations Committee can come. This going from \$20 a day to \$50
