SENATOR LEWIS: Have you all voted? Have you all voted?
Senator Beutler.

SENATOR LEWIS: It has been returned and when it gets to Select File we will take that issue up. We are on Final Reading now. We will not revert back to Select File. We will read the next bill.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Has that been the...?

SENATOR LEWIS: Absolutely.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SENATOR LEWIS: Are there any other questions before we go to Final Reading or are we through with the gymnastics? Read the next bill.

CLERK: (Read LB 442 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR LANDIS: Point of order, Mr. Speaker, I'm sorry.

SENATOR LEWIS: What is the point?

SENATOR LANDIS: I'm sorry. I pushed my button and I meant to get your attention in that way. Just yesterday we had a Final Reading bill that was brought back. The amendment was put on at that point and then we were going to have Final Reading a day or two later.
