LB 602, 654

SENATOR WESELY: I move that LB 602 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. The motion carried, the bill is advanced.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move LB...

SPEAKER MARVEL: 645, Senator Nichol, 645 is to be passed over.

SENATOR WESELY: Oh, I'm sorry.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is that right? Okay. 654.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 654.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. The motion carried. The E & R amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Nichol now moves to amend the bill. (Read Nichol amendment found on page 653 of the Journal.) That is offered by Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature, this is a technical amendment. In LB 654 we allowed the inclusion of cul de sacs and dead end streets in street improvement districts. The amendment relates to the section dealing with objections to proposed improvements. If we are going to include cul de sacs and dead end streets in these districts then it is only fair that these property owners have the same objection rights as others in the district. Mr. Chairman, I move for the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Nichol amendment to LB 654. All those in favor of that amendment vote aye, opposed no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to adopt Senator Nichol's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The amendment is adopted. Okay, Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: I move the advancement of LB 654 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Do you have some items to read in?
